Info for your Alaskan Adventure

Wadleigh Island is in The Tongass National Forest, the largest intact temperate rainforest in the world! You must be prepared for the rain. It is important for you to be dry. You may be fishing, kayaking, hiking, or digging for clams (and eating lots of them, too!). Be sure to bring a couple pairs of durable outdoor shoes, and plenty of warm socks. We have rain gear and boots for fishing.

All of your salt water fishing gear is provided, and we also have basic spin casting gear for the freshwater fishing. However, if you plan to do any fly fishing, we ask that you bring your own fly fishing gear.

Please keep in mind that Alaska Airlines charges for checked bags, but you should be able to manage with just one checked bag and one carry-on. Duffle-type bags work best, especially on the float planes/prop jets between Ketchikan and Prince of Wales Island.

Things you will need:

- Most importantly: if you are planning to fish ... a fishing license. Please purchase it before you arrive. You can purchase one by going to: www.adfg.state.ak.us. You should purchase a one week license for your stay – even if you only fish a couple of days. You should also plan to purchase a King salmon stamp, but please talk to us first, so we can let you know if it will be necessary.

- flashlight or headlamp

- Hiking boots (or other short boots) and a pair of "inside shoes" (maybe slippers). (Outside shoes can get muddy).

- A light rain jacket (we have heavy rain gear for fishing). Staying

dry is essential. Layers work best.

- beanie-type cap for warmth and a baseball-type cap for the sun.

- your personal toiletries (we have shampoo, conditioner, and body wash in the showers).
- Bathing suit if you think you might want to enjoy our wood-fired cedar sauna
- your favorite snack-type goodies: granola bars, trail mix, jerky (we supply many, but we may not have your favorite!)

- Did you know
- while you are at Eagles Wings all of your food and lodging is taken care of, but you may want something in town. If you choose to spend time in town there are: pizza places, coffee shops, a bakery, a grocery store, souvenir shops, a swim center, etc. The towns of Craig and Klawock are 15 min.s away by boat.

- Smoking is only allowed outside the buildings on the Eagles Wings

property.

- Cell service can be spotty on the E.W. property (we've found AT&T works best). We do have wi-fi, but please remember: you're on vacation!!

What to expect when you arrive in Ketchikan:

- Walk downstairs and check in with "Island Air Express"

(BTW: their website is: www.islandairx.com); or if you are taking the Inter-Island Ferry to Hollis walk downstairs and outside the airport building and walk down the ramp to the small ferry that takes you over to the mainland where you will catch the Inter-Island Ferry.
